What data do we collect?

The Friday Island asbl collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, etc.)

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide the Friday Island asbl with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online for any of our services (i.e. newsletter).
- Register online for any of our events.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback via our contact form or email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

How will we use your data?

The Friday Island asbl collects your data so that we can:

- Process your registration and manage your participation.
- Email you with news and information about the Nomadic Island project.

When and with whom do we share your information?

We may share the personal information described in the “What data do we collect?” section with a selection of service providers and third parties. We work with the following types of third party service providers who help us provide, maintain and improve our services:

- Technology providers or potential partners to store information, provide software, or programs to help us provide the services, notably SQUARE (website), GOOGLE DRIVE (storage);
- Financial partners, like financial institutions, payment networks, payment card associations, and credit bureaus that help us provide the services, notably Banque et Caisse d'Epargne de l'Etat;
- Partners and Sponsors, notably Oeuvre Nationale de Secours Grande-Duchesse Charlotte, Commune de Differdange, Service National de la Jeunesse, Fondation Sommer, Fondation Indépendance, Foodsharing Luxembourg, Esch2022 Capitale Européenne de la Culture 2022 asbl.

How do we store your data?

The Friday Island asbl stores your data at its own premises and with the assistance of third-party service providers. We take reasonable measures, including administrative, technical, and physical safeguards, to protect your information from loss, theft, and misuse, and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction. Nevertheless, the internet is not a 100% secure environment, and we cannot guarantee absolute security of the transmission or storage of your information.

The Friday Island asbl will keep your personal identification information until December 31, 2022. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data both from our local and cloud based storage.

If you have agreed to receive marketing, you may always opt out at a later date. You have the right at any time to stop the Friday Island asbl from contacting you for marketing purposes.

What are your data protection rights?

The Friday Island asbl would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request the Friday Island asbl for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that the Friday Island asbl correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request the Friday Island asbl to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that the Friday Island asbl erase your personal data, under certain conditions¹.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that the Friday Island asbl restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions².

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to the Friday Island asbl's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions³.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that the Friday Island asbl transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

How do we use cookies?

The Friday Island asbl uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, including:

- Keeping you signed in
- Understanding how you use our website

What types of cookies do we use?

There are a number of different types of cookies, however, our website uses:

- **Functionality** – The Friday Island asbl uses these cookies so that we recognize you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. These could include what language you prefer and location you are in. A mix of first-party and third-party cookies are used.
- **Advertising** – The Friday Island asbl uses these cookies to collect information about your visit to our website, the content you viewed, the links you followed and information about your browser, device, and your IP address. The Friday Island asbl sometimes shares some limited aspects of this data with third parties for advertising purposes. We may also share online data collected through cookies with our advertising partners. This means that when you visit another website, you may be shown advertising based on your browsing patterns on our website.

How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and the above website tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.

Privacy policies of other websites

The Nomadic Island website by the Friday Island asbl contains links to other websites. Our privacy policy applies only to our website, so if you click on a link to another website, you should read their privacy policy.
